Delivery conditions

The following conditions apply to the acceptance of scrap tyres, waste rubber and Used tyres at KURZ Karkassenhandel GmbH at the Wendlingen/Neckar and Landau/Pfalz locations:

The acceptance criteria must be agreed and binding prior to delivery. This agreement applies as the basis for a contract.

Please register your deliveries at least one day beforehand. If deliveries are not registered, we reserve the right to refuse to accept them.

Before unloading the agreed fractions, the supplier/haulier must report to the order reception / office / scales and provide accurate information about the delivery quantity and the contents / nature of the fraction.

During the unloading procedure or / and afterwards, each delivery must be sorted and re-checked by the KURZ employees. The results are recorded in writing. The invoice is produced on the basis of these documents and on the basis of the delivery papers.

The delivered fractions may not be soiled, and interfering materials / foreign bodies such as grease, mud, screws, cans and other types of waste will be removed by KURZ against a charge and taken for other types of recycling, which is also billable. The cost of consequential damage caused by interfering materials which are not discovered (machine breakage) will also be passed on accordingly.

We also reserve the right to charge a sorting cost flat rate if mixed fractions are delivered, which is currently € 150.-.

If tyres are delivered which have been loaded with an excavator, we reserve the right to make an additional charge of € 50,- per ton.

If contaminated or coloured tyres, silo tyres and tyres with sealant are delivered, we reserve the right to refuse to accept them or make an appropriate additional charge per tyre depending on the size of the tyre:

- Car € 1.20
- Light commercial vehicle € 3.00
- HGV € 6.00
- Motorcycle € 1.00
- tractor up to 1.3m/0.35m € 8.00
- tractor up to 1.8m/0.35m € 12.00
- Earth mover and solid rubber tyres depending on size and weight.

If the above-mentioned points are explicitly agreed, the exclusion regulations which have been mentioned are null and void.

If delivery is made without mention of a company name, we must insist on checking and copying of a personal ID or passport and payment in cash.

If payments are outstanding or the business basis is missing, we reserve the right to refuse any delivery.

Please note that the maximum speed of 10 km/h applies on our operating site in accordance with the StVO. Sufficient protective clothing must also be worn, and high-visibility jackets are available at reception against a deposit.
